

In 2011, Yashoda Group of Hospitals organisation wanted to set up an orphanage, with the goal of better understanding the needs and challenges of the orphans. The board of directors visited several orphanages in and around Hyderabad. One particular issue emerged to be common across all discussions – the need for skill development and job placement for orphans who leave the orphanages at the age of 16-18 years.

Yashoda Foundation was thus established in 2011 with the primary objective of making orphans and underprivileged youth employable by providing them skill development training, life skills workshops, counseling sessions and job placement program. The Foundation follows a framework that provides a positive and practical outlook; essential education and hands-on experience to empower orphan youth to succeed.

We strive to empower orphan youth by providing skill development training and job placements, thus enabling them to become productive contributors of the society



Project ABHAYA

Social Inclusion through Employment Linked Training Programme for Orphan Youth

With an aim of offering the benefit of the Employment Linked Training Programme to the orphans, the Yashoda Foundation initiated this project providing training with the most prominent training partners and in collaboration with placement providers. The training process follows required customization, keeping in mind the needs of the specific target group.

Supported by rigorous job oriented & skill development training, the programme offers 100 % placement support.

The course duration is of 3 months and new batches comprising a minimum of 45 to 50 aspirants starts every month.

The training process begins with the Foundation Course Programme to train the aspirants in:

- Life skills such as self confidence, positive thinking, communication skills, team building, decisionmaking, time and money management, psychiatric counseling and personality development
- 'Communicative English', as the ability to speak in English has become an important prerequisite at
- Basic Computers Skills, which will be helpful for the aspirants at their workplace

Eligibility Criteria:

• Age - 16 to 21 years • Qualification - 10th class or Intermediate • Unmarried

Support provided to the trainees:

- Free education and training
- Hostel and boarding facility for non-local candidates & transportation charges for local candidates
- Study material, Books, Stationery and all needs of the candidates during the training course



- Certificate on completion of training course
- Placement for all the trained candidates
- Training on Interview Skills and guidance on how to face interviews

Monitoring the programme

- Volunteers can also participate as Guest Faculty to motivate and guide the trainees
- Visit to the hostels of Yashoda Foundation for mentoring and motivating the trainees
- Monitoring and counseling of candidates already placed for better career growth

AKSHARA

Tuition Support Programme for Orphan Children

In addition to the main objective programme, the board of the Yashoda Foundation realized the critical need of improving the academics of the orphan children. They observed that most of the students studying in class 6th to 10th need support to improve their performance in subjects such as Mathematics, Science and English, as these are the only subjects they find difficult. The Tuition Support Programme was launched to cater to this need.

Initially, an assessment of the need for tuition support in the orphan homes was done and a few orphan homes seeking the support were shortlisted. The Foundation currently supports 50 orphan homes with 69 tuition volunteers. As a result of this programme, the pass percentage in these orphan homes has increased to 90%.

Highlights of the programme are as follows:

- Tutors visit orphanage homes on a daily basis to teach these subjects through easy learning methodologies
- The marks of every unit test are considered and compared to assess the improvement in concerned subjects
- The Foundation provides honorarium for all the Tuition Volunteers
- Monitoring volunteers visit the orphan homes to assess the impact of the programme and to ensure day to day improvements of the programme
