01.	14.10.2025	On being mentioned by Sri Biswapriya Kanungo, a human rights activist, this case is taken up. This complaint is at the instance of Dunna Kumar Nallabodduluru claiming to be brother of D. Keshavarao Azad who is incarcerated in Special Jail, Jharapada, Bhubaneswar, being allegedly involved in Naxalite activities in the State of Andhra Pradesh and Odisha. It is stated that though he surrendered in Andhra Pradesh but brought to Odisha as he was involved in many such cases here in this State. But his trial in the State of Andhra Pradesh and Odisha is not completed though his incarceration is more than 14 years in jail. As such a petition under Article 32 of Constitution of India was filed before the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Writ Petition(s) (Criminal) No.(s)511/2024 wherein the Hon'ble Apex Court in no uncertain terms directed both the States to take expeditious steps to complete all formalities and establish the Special Courts by 31.08.2025 and conclude the trial of the petitioner within one year. But there is no progress in this regard by the State of Odisha to comply with such direction of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in spite of direction of the Hon'ble Supreme Court

Mr. Biswapriya Kanungo submits that inadvertently, this matter has been addressed to NHRC while writing the same to this Commission. As such he filed a fresh petition in this Commission to take up the matter. Considering the same, the matter is taken up inasmuch as speedy trial is guaranteed under Article 21 of the Constitution of India and long incarceration in jail as U.T.P. is violation of human rights being violative of Article 21 of the Constitution. Perused the order of Hon'ble Supreme Court. It appears that in paragraph – 7 Hon'ble Apex Court held as follows: “xxxx xxxx xxxx 7. <i>Similarly, the State of Orissa will also complete all formalities and establish the Special Courts by 31.08.2025. The delay, if any, in this regard shall be viewed seriously.</i> xxxx xxxx xxxx.” Considering the submission of Mr. Kanungo and after perusal of the petition so also the order of Hon'ble Supreme Court, this Commission takes cognizance of the matter and consequently call for a report from the
